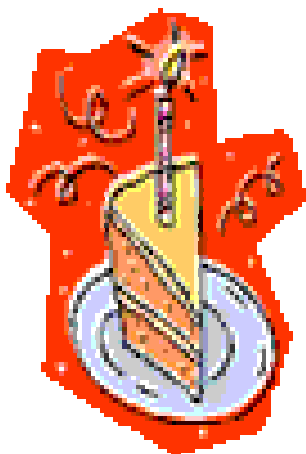
Keynsham Gala is on Saturday 28th March.
